THE RCCF RUSH COUNTY 4-H JUNIOR LEADER SCHOLARSHIP

Applicants for this scholarship must:

- be a current Rush County Junior Leader.
- be a graduating senior in high school and intend to further their education at any accredited vocational/technical school, or a 2-year/4-year college or university.
- have at least 4 years in good standing in Junior Leaders.
- include two letters of reference with at least one letter being from their local 4-H Club adult volunteer leader.
- Selection will be based on Junior Leader participation and involvement-50%; school and community activities-10%; financial needs of the member-15%; total number of 4-H projects completed-10%; and the discretion of the committee-15%.

In order to be considered for this scholarship, a completed application package must be submitted to the Rush County Community Foundation office by the application deadline as stated on the scholarship application.

- 2. A current official transcript or a copy of a current official transcript showing credits attempted, credits earned and grades**
- 3. One current signed letter of reference from their local 4-H adult leader (Email letters not accepted)**
- 4. One current signed letter of reference (Email letters not accepted)**
- 5. Number of years in Junior Leaders _____**
- 6. Current FAFSA Form**
