The RCCF Maurice W. “Porky” Wainwright Scholarship

Applicants for this scholarship must:

- be a graduate from RCHS who is not attending college, but is interested in improving their skills in the home building trade’s area. (May be a high school senior or someone already graduated.)
- attend a technical or professional school (not a college) to receive training in home building trades (carpenter, plumber, electrician, etc.)

Preference will be given to qualified applicants pursuing a building trades career (carpenter, electrician, plumbing, heating, etc.), but if there are no such applicants, another vocational career pursuit will be considered.

In order to be considered for this scholarship, a completed application package must be submitted to the Rush County Community Foundation office by the application deadline as stated on the scholarship application.

- 2. A current official transcript or a copy of a current official transcript showing credits attempted, credits earned and grades**
- 3. Current FAFSA Form**
